**ELIGIBLE:** Open to Sonoma/Marin residents: 4-9 years and under as of 08/05/18  
**CHECK-IN TIME:** Sunday, August 5th: 12:00 p.m.–12:30 p.m. at CHRIS BECK ARENA TICKET BOOTH.  
**AWARDS:** 4-6 Year Old Division: Champion Rosette; 7-9 Year Old Division: Champion Buckle

## RULES

1. All contestants must complete (with parent/guardian signature) a "Release & Hold Harmless Waiver" on or before check-in.
2. Contestants have 2 options: You may provide your own stick horse, decorated at home, or be one of the first 25 to pre-register to receive a complimentary stick horse. You must fill out this application before you can participate in Farmers Day activities. **Blue Ribbons will be awarded to all home-made horses!**
3. At check-in at the box-office, you will receive a voucher to be redeemed for your horse at the "Stick Horse Corral" located inside the gate next to the Kid's Fun Center. There will be a "decoration station if you want to decorate your horse. (*decorations will be limited*)
4. Contestants must have checked-in and receive a voucher for your horse and a participation ribbon to participate.
5. Contestants will be eligible to participate in the "Stick Horse Drill" at opening ceremonies as well as participate in the contest later in the program.
6. Contestants will be judged on the following criteria:
7. Costume – Western Attire
8. Decoration of Stick Horse
9. Performance of short routine (walk, trot, gallop, slide stop, back up, etc)

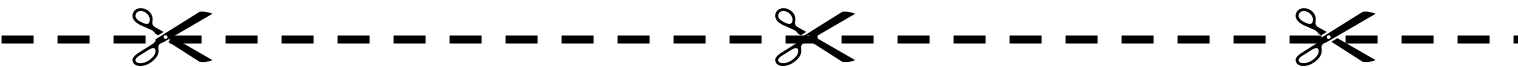
