Rules

1. All animals must be identified by permanent ear marking or ear tag conforming with the entry on arrival at the show. Any duplication of ear markings, by one exhibitor, in the same division must be eliminated and the change recorded on the judging sheet before judging. Animals presenting without an ear marking will be refused.
2. The date of birth (month-year), breed and variety must be entered on the entry form for each animal entered in breed divisions.
3. Exhibitors are responsible to care for animals. Fair will provide access to feed, water and shavings. Feeding and watering should be completed by 9:00 a.m. daily.
4. All crocks must be cleaned by exhibitor upon departure.
5. Carrying cages may be stored under cages as long as they are out of view.
6. Exhibitor is responsible for providing the ear marking/tattoo and the correct breed, variety/show classification, age classification and sex in accordance with the ARBA Standard of Perfection for each animal entered.
7. Animals will be shown and judged in the proper division and class for breed, variety, age and sex only. If no division is offered, no awards may be made. Rabbits that are disqualified because of permanent defects, deformities or blemishes do not count when computing the number of exhibitors in the class.
8. **STATE RULE:** No exhibitor shall receive more than 2 cash awards in any one class.
9. **STATE RULE:** In the Senior Department, members of a family are considered as one exhibitor and co-owners of exhibits.

Division 1901 – Open Cavy Awards

Grand Champion Cavy.....by Sonoma County Fair
 Best of Breed(s).....Rosette
 Best Opposite Sex of Breed(s).....Rosette
Cavies will be divided into Divisions after close of entries. Breeds must have at least 5 animals entered by at least 3 exhibitors to qualify for a separate division. All others will be shown under "Miscellaneous" division.

Division 1902 – Cavies

Class

1. Senior Boar – Over 32 ounces
2. Senior Sow – Over 32 ounces
3. Intermediate Boar – 22 ounces & up to & including 32 ounces, up to six months of age.
4. Intermediate Sow – 22 ounces & up to & including 32 ounces, up to six months of age.
5. Junior Boar-Min weight of 12 ounces & max weight of 22 ounces, up to 4 months old.
6. Junior Sow-Min weight of 12 ounces & max weight of 22 ounces, up to 4 months old.
