- For security reasons, all livestock barns will be closed, with no access between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. These enforced barn hours will begin on the evening of each market species arrival/check-in day, and continue through the date that each species is transported from the fairgrounds to the processing facility, following the auctions.
- Please have hogs washed before they arrive! Hogs that arrive dirty will be immediately sent to the wash rack.

JUNIOR MARKET HOGS

Rules

- A. Exhibitors will be responsible for bringing their hog from pen to sales ring then back to the pen on the day of the auction. Adult assistance will be provided by the Fair, no parent or leader assistance will be permitted. Exhibitors are responsible for feeding and watering their animals until they are sold at the Auction.
- B. Tack will be released Wednesday, August 8 after 6:00 p.m. Access to water should remain in pens to keep animal hydrated.
- C. All Market Hog exhibitors are eligible to enter showmanship. Pre-entry into showmanship is required. Weight or judge sifted animals may be exhibited in showmanship class. All sifted livestock must be removed at conclusion of showmanship.
- D. After weighing, market hogs will be divided into weight classes within the specified limitations as desired for convenience in judging. Breed classification is determined at scale.
- E. Min weight for any market hog is 220 lbs. Hogs weighing under 220 lbs. will be sifted.
- F. Maximum weight is 270. Any hog weighing over 270 will be sifted at the scale.
- G. Any hog weighing over 255 lbs. (but under 270 lbs) will not be sifted for weight, but will not be paid for over 255 lbs.
- H. Gilts exhibited in the market swine Divisions may not be exhibited in the breeding Divisions or vice versa. Any violation of this rule will exclude the exhibitor from competition in all departments of the fair.
- I. No clipping will be allowed on the Fairgrounds.
- J. **Market Animal Fitting: No hair or skin dyes, paints or colorants (including powder), or adhesives are allowed to be used. No products or materials may be used to manipulate the hair on legs. Exhibitors may continue to use oils or clear coat products to enhance shine as well as external applications of substances for appearance to the hoofs. No shadow painting or practices that change the animal's natural appearance.**
- K. All hogs must arrive with fair issued eartags attached to the left ear as you stand behind the hog (see DNA instructions for picture) with the number showing on back of ear. Any hogs unloaded that don't have eartags in ear will be disqualified.
No Exceptions!
- L. The FFA Champion Market Hog, FFA Reserve Champion Market Hog, 4-H Champion Market Hog and 4-H Reserve Champion Market Hog will be diverted to official testing area and tested for drug residue, immediately after the judge selects them in the show ring. For more information see Junior Livestock Auction Rules at the beginning of this Department.
- M. Please see Department 53 for showmanship rules.

Independent Juniors:

Independent Juniors **must have the following items on file with the fairgrounds Entry Office by June 30:**

- full photo of the animal
- proof of ownership (bill of sale, etc.)
- proof of grade school enrollment
