4. **NEW Breeding Animals Fitting: Changing the natural color of the animal is prohibited. No shadow painting. Exhibitors may use products that enhance the natural color of the animal.**

Rules

1. A permanent eartag or tattoo is required and must be listed on entry form along with the animals birth date.
2. Animals that have been registered by a purebred association cannot be entered in this division if they are entered in purebred divisions.
3. All lambs must be shown slick shorn.
4. Unregistered lambs must arrive and depart with the rest of junior sheep.
5. All lambs must show lambs teeth.
6. Unregistered Sheep may compete for Supreme Champion Ram, Ewe or Flock.
