4. Pre-entry into showmanship is required. Exhibitors must enter showmanship by close of entries. Please see Department 53 for showmanship rules.

7. Breeding Animals Fitting: Changing the natural color of the animal is prohibited. No shadow painting. Exhibitors may use products that enhance the natural color of the animal.

 23. Produce of Dam: Two does, produce of same dam. One entry by same dam per exhibitor. The Dam must be identified by registration number on entry form.
