4. Breeding Animals Fitting: Changing the natural color of the animal is prohibited. No shadow painting. Exhibitors may use products that enhance the natural color of the animal.

Rules

1. A permanent eartag or tattoo is required and must be listed on entry form along with the animals birth date.
2. Animals that have been registered by a purebred association cannot be entered in this division if they are entered in purebred divisions.
3. All lambs must be shown slick shorn.
4. Unregistered lambs must arrive and depart with the rest of junior sheep.
5. All lambs must show lambs teeth.
6. Unregistered Sheep may compete for Supreme Champion Ram, Ewe or Flock.

Rules

1. Age will be determined as of opening day of fair. See class breakdown below.
2. Lead contestants may show any age ewe. (*Rams not allowed.*)
3. All sheep must be conditioned, fitted, and trained to show at halter.
4. All contestants are to wear an outfit made of a minimum of 60% wool.
5. Note: You do not need to own the sheep used in lead classes.
6. You do not need to sew the outfits or costumes. They can be store bought as long as they meet the wool requirements.
7. Entries will be judged on mode of dress selected, which must be appropriate, attractive and lend elegance to the Class.
8. Entries in these classes will be open to anyone meeting the requirements listed below. The objectives of this class are to present a class of sheep in the most attractive manner, to give spectators a real opportunity to view a class of beauty and to enhance the image of the Sheep Industry.
