Rules

- A. Junior Yearling sows must show evidence of raising a litter of pigs to be eligible for entry.
- B. Gilts exhibited in the market swine divisions may not be exhibited in the breeding Divisions or vice versa. Any violation of this rule will exclude the exhibitor from competition in all departments of the fair.
- C. No boars will be allowed in showmanship.
- D. Fair will not be requiring animals to be blood tested for pseudorabies.
- E. Pre-entry into showmanship is required. Exhibitors must enter showmanship by close of entries. Please see Department 52 for showmanship rules.
- F. Breeding Animals Fitting: Changing the natural color of the animal is prohibited. No shadow painting. Exhibitors may use products that enhance the natural color of the animal.
- G. **STATE RULE: Substitutions can only be made within a division. Substitutions must be made when the exhibit arrives at the fairgrounds. A minimum \$20 penalty must be paid prior to judging for each substitution made by the exhibitor in excess of two in the division.**

Note: The Fair reserves the right to change division breeds if numbers warrant.
