Rules

1. Each steer must be pre-entered on this form. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Entry must be filled out and returned by **June 28, 2019**.
2. Cow must be bred or artificially inseminated in Sonoma or Marin County.
3. Embryo transfer calves may occur ONLY if the recipient cow is a Sonoma or Marin County Owned cow and the transfer takes place In Sonoma or Marin County.
4. Once bred, the cow must remain in Sonoma or Marin County.
5. Calf must be born and raised in Sonoma or Marin County. Once the calf is weaned it must remain in Sonoma or Marin County, with the exception of jackpot shows, until it is sold at the Sonoma County Fair.
6. Market Steers can only be purchased DIRECTLY from the Sonoma or Marin County breeder by the exhibitor.
7. Local grown steers cannot be purchased from an auction, sale, or broker.
8. Sponsors are responsible for enforcing the rules of this contest.
9. By signing this entry form exhibitor, breeder and broker attest that the steer meets all the criteria for admission to the class.
