

2010 SONOMA COUNTY FAIR FLOWER SHOW SCHOLARSHIP

4-YEAR COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Sonoma County Fair & Exposition Inc. will offer scholarships ranging from \$1,000 to \$2,500 to students who have graduated from high school and are planning to attend college in the fall. Eligibility is limited to individuals who are pursuing a degree in an agricultural related enterprise.

Scholarships are open to any student whose family resides in Sonoma or Marin Counties. Candidates must meet one of the following criteria:

- **Students transferring from S.R.J.C. to a 4-year college as an agricultural major (must be transferring this year).**
- **High school graduates of this year going directly to a 4-year college as an agricultural major.**
- **Continuing students majoring in agricultural at a 4-year college earning their first degree. (Individuals seeking an advanced degree are not eligible)**

Money for these scholarships is generated from the Flower Show Preview. *Recipients must be present at the Hall of Flowers Preview to receive scholarship money.* Recipients will be limited to a maximum of two times to receive any scholarship.

Applications are available at the Fairgrounds Entry Office or the Santa Rosa Junior College Agriculture Department. Completed applications are due in the Entry Office of the Sonoma County Fair by 5:00 p.m., Friday, May 28th. Applicants will be judged on neatness and completeness of application, and oral interview. Applicants will be pre-screened. The pre-screened finalists will be contacted for interviews. Applicants will be contacted by phone to inform them of their interview time. No rescheduling will be permitted.

- Applicants must be present for the interview (and in uniform if applicable). Interviews will be held on Friday, June 18th starting at 8:30 a.m. at the Sonoma County Fair Director's Room.
- Recipient must be present at Hall of Flowers Preview, Sunday July 25, 2010 from 6-8 pm.

Scholarship checks will be mailed upon proof of registration. *One half of the money will be given Fall quarter or semester and on half at Spring quarter or semester.* The funds will only be available for one year following June 18, 2010.
